

# Bath Athletic Boosters

May 16, 2005

The meeting was called to order by Vice-President Nan Bendall at 7:03 p.m.

**Secretary's Report:** The secretarial minutes were distributed from the April 18, 2005 meeting and approved as presented.

**Treasurer's Report:** After distribution of the report, the following issues were discussed. MSU said they sent a check for \$6,000 three weeks ago but it has not showed up yet. Ruth will continue to track it down. The soccer account has \$150, not \$300. Norm will make the correction. Ann Chaffee requested that a sub-account be established, breaking out freshman girls basketball funds (approx. \$1100). We currently have \$1,000 in the money market account. Except for one business that asked to have the donation returned (will support it next year) everyone agreed to just have their donation moved to next year. The account has sufficient funds to support the scholarships for next year.

Sandy thanked Catherine Meyers for her assistance in getting the word out about the scholarships. She also thanked members Trixie Brown, Rick Hammond, Alicia & Randy Paape. Next year, Trixie will chair the committee, Rick will serve his second year and three new committee members will be recruited.

**Recognition of Sue and Brian Nelson:** Keith recapped the award presentation for Howard Roberson and Bill McKenna that took place at the Busy Bee. Keith also presented Brian & Sue Nelson with a plaque recognizing their outstanding service to the Boosters over the years. Keith highlighted a brief history of their involvement with the Boosters and a sincere thank you was extended by all present.
