

Bath Athletic Boosters

October 15, 2007

The meeting was called to order by President Gray Bendall at 7:05 p.m.

Secretary's Report (Margie Sisson): Secretary Sisson presented the minutes and distributed 2007-2008 membership forms. The "Field Maintenance Cost Request from the Coaches" which was tabled at the September meeting was again tabled until the November meeting (there are concerns about using Booster funds for maintenance items). Todd Setter (Youth Football) did make note that Youth Football will pay for part of the costs for the football field and that he and the varsity coach have spoken. A notice will be submitted to the DBR regarding the November meeting times/location. Old record boards will be given to the athlete whose name is on each of the boards. A list was forwarded to Webmaster Sue Garrity for posting.

Treasurer's Report (Norm Slee): According to the treasurer's report the team accounts are looking good and there is approximately \$7500 in the non-team accounts. The possibility of opening a money market still needs to be reviewed. The baseball account issue and the football account issue (\$180 transfer/sign/Zeeb) will be addressed by Norm. Deposit slips were turned into Norm and monies were given to Gray (cheerleading/volleyball) to deposit. Norm requested that all deposit slips show where the money should be credited, i.e., clothing, concessions, etc. Emailing him the deposit amounts is very helpful. Concessions for the MS cross invitational didn't make very much money and it needs to be reviewed prior to the next time. It was noted that girl's freshman basketball still shows as a line item. Norm will check the Craig Poppema prior to combining them. Todd Setter thanked the Boosters for the opportunity to work concessions and raise money for youth football.

Concessions: Post Prom usually handles winter concessions at the elementary school. Last year it was handled by one of the basketball teams. Margie will check with Annette Flegal (head of Post Prom this year) to see if any parents in the junior class are interested in working it for post prom and she will report back to the Boosters next month. NOTE: The concession pole barn will be winterized Oct. 22-23 and concession supplies will be moved inside Friday night after the game.

Clothing/Gear: The scholar athlete shirts for this year will be royal blue with white lettering (Scholar Athlete on front/textbooks on sleeve/sports on back). Approximately 150 sports bags will be purchased. Gray will contact Sue Garrity regarding the posting of the athlete's names on the Booster website.

New Business:

- Gray will check with Sue Garrity to see if she wants help with the website
- Todd Setter owns BathBees.com and BathSports.com-possibilities?

- ❑ Two flagpoles and flags will be added to the Mel Comeau track complex. Banners instead of plaques will be used for schools in our league.
- ❑ Gray is on a mission to locate a white board, bulletin board and clock for concessions (inside too?). **[Mark and Joe Houghton each found a clock for use in the coaches room and concessions-installed for the game against PW-thanks guys!]**
- ❑ Needed equipment for ms/new popcorn machine (approximately \$1500). Todd Setter offered to list the old popcorn machine on eBay for Boosters (expect 12-18% costs for shipping/handling) at no charge to Boosters. **Thanks Todd!**
- ❑ Popcorn butter/oil has been recalled due to an ingredient that causes “popcorn lung”. Gray will return what stock we have for the alternative.
