The meeting was called to order by President Rick Hammond at 7:08 p.m.

Secretary's Report (A. Paape for M. Sisson): Gray and Norm discussed the GTM account and reconciled. Minutes approved.

- ❑ Discussion about Post-Prom committee working concessions for Tri-County games and Youth basketball at the elementary school. Post-Prom needs to talk with sophomore class parents.
- ❑ Stinger Ad: Great Job/Congrats Golf Team – Good Luck Winter Sports Team! Bath Athletic Boosters (2 lines)
- ❑ Baseball update: Spring trip during spring break in Asheville, North Carolina. Coach Orr will be approaching Board regarding a cement pad & new bleachers around baseball diamond.
- ❑ Tri-County Basketball-games need to be moved to new gym because concessions are only in the new gym area. (Update: On Dec. 9 volleyball competed in the new gym and the Tri-County Basketball games were moved to the middle school).
