

# Bath Athletic Boosters

February 19, 2007

**The meeting was called to order by President Rick Hammond at 7:00 p.m.**

**Secretary's Report (Margie Sisson):** The minutes were distributed and reviewed. A discussion about **Unity in Community Day** (May 1<sup>st</sup>) followed. Any Boosters jobs needing to be done should be forwarded on to Rick Hammond. Once a list is compiled, he will forward it on to Maryanne Boylan. One of our regular yearly jobs is requesting a thorough trash pick up by the students of the Mel Comeau Track Complex. The bulletin "**Food for Thought**" from the Mid-Michigan Health Department was passed around. Discussed the possibility of sending someone to attend the Food-Service manager certification program (\$35-non profit groups). This is a more advanced training program over the basic program free of charge for food-service operators and owners. No interest at this time. The minutes were approved as presented.

**Treasurer's Report (Norm Slee):** The treasurer's report was presented. Norm stated that, as requested, he will transfer \$1,000 per month from clothing into the project fund.

Non-Team accounts (**\$9,224.60**): Clothing (\$1,095.43); Concessions (\$6,294.97); General Fund (\$451.64); Project fund (\$1,385.56). The treasurer's report was approved.

**President's Report (Rick Hammond):** Stated that he was glad to see that the banners were being hung. Gray took this opportunity to fill us in on future plans of **banner hanging and record board hanging**. Two schools will be joining our league next year (Carson City and Dansville). Discussion ensued about the condition of the new gym floor. It was also mentioned that during extreme weather, snow is coming in the NW door in the old gym.

**Concessions/Clothing (Gray Bendall):**

Gray discussed moving the trophies and **March 9** (no school on this day) was chosen as the day to do it. There are 14 sections of case and 15 sports. Rob Orr suggested an area to highlight/celebrate the anniversary of a special event of a particular sport. Great idea Rob! Mention was made of the **cross-country records boards**. Gray will contact Doc to make sure they are all updated.
