The meeting was called to order by President Rick Hammond at 7:03 p.m.

Secretary's Report (Margie Sisson): The minutes were distributed and reviewed. A discussion about **Unity in Community Day** (May 1st) followed. Any Booster jobs needing to be done should be forwarded on to Rick Hammond. All documentation regarding equipment (such as information for the scales) should be forwarded on to the Athletic Department (E. Harrelson). The issue of a heater/enclosed unit was discussed for the popcorn machine.

MOTION: Sisson moved to authorize Gray Bendall to purchase a popcorn heater. Seconded by Slee. Passed unanimously. Gray will be going to a big sale this Friday and will investigate a stainless steel enclosed popcorn stand. Minutes were approved as presented.

Courser/Nugent Scholarship update (Ann Chaffee/Trixie Brown): It was decided to keep both scholarships at \$500. Co-chairs Trixie Brown and Ann Caffee will proceed with distributing the scholarship information. They will contact Mary Jane Nugent to verify any questions about the Nugent and they will also contact Cory Leslie (Counselor) and Sue Garrity (Webmaster & scholarship committee member). Carl Chaffee and Joe Sisson are the other committee members. Trixie will have students put up signs around the school. It was recommended to invite the Coursers/Nugent to Seniors Honor Night (when scholarships are presented--Senior Honors Night-May 15).

Nugent/Courser Update (Tom Cooley): Sponsors are needed for both events. Rick will count the medals for the Courser to make sure we have enough. Trophies need to be ordered. The DBR has not run the article Tom submitted 3 weeks ago. He will check back with them.

Treasurer's Report (Norm Slee): Norm distributed the report and will make corrections to the following: Baseball, Softball, and General Fund. Additional deposits were given to Norm, increasing the non team accounts by approximately \$1000.

President's Report (Rick Hammond): Rick commended everyone involved in the trophy case project for their work. The cases look excellent! Plans for the possibility of a press box were discussed, golf scramble, and Liam Boylan-Pett's recent honors. Rick also read from an article he printed off the Internet which elicited discussion regarding Friday night's boys' basketball game. Another item discussed was a suggestion that we may want to check with our Athletic Department on whatever happened to the proposed League Team Sportsmanship Award that was in the works a few years back.

Softball Team – Trip (Marc Kibby):

Marc requested an advance of monies for the trip South in the amount of \$3500.

MOTION: Tom moved and Gray seconded an advance of \$3500 which will be repaid from Breslin fundraising funds. Motion passed.

Concessions/Clothing (Gray Bendall): Gray is in the process of updating all the state plaques and requested information from Marc (softball) and Rob (baseball). Custom Sign Works approached Marc about a fundraising project involving plaques that he will bring to the group.
