The meeting was called to order by President Rick Hammond at 7:05 p.m.

Secretary's Report (Margie Sisson): Secretary Sisson will submit an advertisement request to the Stinger for their final issue. The "Taste of Clinton County" thanked the Boosters in the DBR (article was read) for their donation.

Treasurer's Report (Norm Slee): All teams have a positive balance (Softball's negative number is from the trip/will be repaid). Another \$1,000 will be transferred to the project fund. Approximately \$9,000 in non-team accounts (does not include recent deposits, etc.). Fundraising issues were discussed. Sharri Margraves volunteered to email the secretary a website of a potential fundraising opportunity for the coaches (see box below). Margie also will email Rick the updated "motions chart" and provide the requested research for the next meeting. Per the request of Coach Wonch, all accounts will be under one account - "Boys Basketball."

President's Report (Rick Hammond): Sue Garrity requested permission to sell girl scout cookies at the Busy Bee (granted). Erik Harrelson-Boy's Plaques. A request was made for the Boosters to provide cookies for the BB team and a jacket for Coach Wonch (approved). Press box-Gray and Rick attended the meeting-idea is to replace existing structure in same location. Rock-Rick will check with Erik on this (need an 8x10 bronze plaque). Sharon Slee is the nominating committee of one. Contact her at 339-8634 if you would like to serve as an officer next year or you would like to nominate a candidate. We will vote next month. Matt Dodson, new football coach, discussed some fundraising projects the team will be working on (golf outing, signs).

VP's Report/Concessions/Clothing (Gray Bendall): Concessions all ready to go. A "line heater" was purchased for the popcorn machine and is all set up (thanks Gray!!). The boys state championship banner is ready for Monday's Board meeting. Shirt sellers needed for the Busy Bee/Courser event. Concession schedule with pizza schedules are posted. Scholar Athlete shirts are done. Gray will check with Erik and Beth Botke at the Township regarding the state champ signs at the three entrances to the township.

Scholarship Committee (Ann Chaffee/Trixie Brown): Two scholarships will be awarded for the Courser and the Nugent. The committee has received 3 courser applications and 15 Nugent applications. Cory Leslie (High School Counselor) did an excellent job of soliciting apps from the students, getting the information out early, and following up with the committee. May 15th is senior award night. The Coursers will not be in attendance this year.

Boys Basketball – Fundraising (Jenny Mills/Denise Wahrer): They have raised \$2,652 to date (excellent!). Jenny distributed a letter they would like to use. [after the meeting the officers requested that she change the heading say Boys Basketball Team, instead of Bath Athletic Boosters].

It is important that the coaches work together on coordinating fundraisers. Tom Cooley mentioned that sponsors were needed for the Courser and the Nugent.
