

# Bath Athletic Boosters

## February 13, 2006

**Present:** Rob Orr, Gray Bendall, Marc Kibby, Rick Hammond, Keith Nelson, Ruth Miehlike, Tom Cooley, Alicia Paape

The meeting was called to order at 7:10 p.m.

**Secretary's Report:** Approved as presented. The minutes indicated that the MS was hosting the CMAC Tournament on March 17, 2006. This was cancelled.

**Treasurer's Report:** (Norm will be adding the "committed" dollars on the treasurer's report)

Total Non-Team Accounts:	\$14,048.17
Total Memorial Accounts:	\$ 3,315.14
Total Team Accounts:	\$33,633.05

The treasurer's report was approved unanimously.

**Middle School Runners/Mats:** The mats look very nice but they're a bit short at 60'. The MS will need about 20' more for the full gym. The maintenance staff said that the mats are not that hard to take care of.

**Senior's Night:** Instead of having all players come down during the games, only have the seniors and their parents come down. Erik is going to have the boy's basketball team do this and Ruth will do the same for volleyball.

**Middle School Concessions:** Regarding the idea that the middle school should take care of their own concessions and the Boosters will get out of doing it. Discussion: The MS teams could get on a concession rotation. It was noted that this would take away concession support from the varsity teams. Discussion about the MS teams getting no funds at all and the need for uniforms. Ruth Miehlike was asked to check into the cost of uniforms for the track team.

### **Request for Funds:**

Bruce Miller would like a loan of \$733 to cover a bill from Johnny Macs. His account only has \$100 in it but he'll reimburse the Boosters within a week. **MOTION: The Bath Athletic Boosters will loan the Varsity Basketball Program \$733, to be repaid within a week. Moved by Keith Nelson, and seconded by Gray Bendall. Discussion: Asking the Boosters before spending the money in the future.**

Marc Kibby requested \$400 for yellow capping for fencing for replacement. **MOTION: The Bath Athletic Boosters will provide \$400 for yellow capping for fencing. Moved by Norm Slee and seconded by Rick Hammond. Approved unanimously.**

**Concessions:** Gray Bendall looking at moving the shelves in the coolers for stacking drinks better. Start marking what drinks go on what shelf for proper shelf stocking by concession workers.

**Spirit Wear:** At the last basketball game against Fowler, the Boosters sold a large portion of their clothing items. The wrestling team (Les) is going to get with Gray/Nan on ordering "Band-Aid" style sweatshirts for the wrestling team.

**Golf Team:** Rainsuits are \$612 for six, however Doug will shop around. Doug Fleming has approached the school and there is no money. **MOTION: The Bath Boosters approved the purchase of golf rainsuits, with a cap of \$700. Moved by Norm Slee and seconded by Tom Cooley. Approved unanimously.**

**MS Storage Room Uniforms:** Discussion on cleaning the room (mopping, repainting, stripping), shelving and the need for totes.

**Uniforms:** After taking inventory, there is a definite need for uniforms. If money is raised, a possible uniform rotation is suggested. All old uniforms will be sold to the students and the money put in a uniform fund. Alicia and Keith are planning to get on the agenda for an upcoming school board meeting to discuss the concerns.

**Bylaws:** Rick passed out the revised bylaws for review. Next month the Boosters will review and discuss the revisions. All comments should go to Rick.
